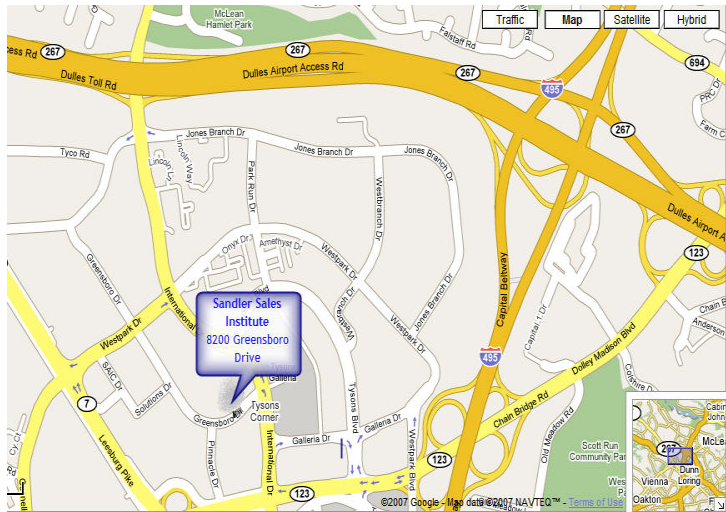

Travel Directions

Via I-66 and/or the Beltway

- Find your way to I-495 near Tysons
- Take Exit 46 (VA 123 SOUTH - Chain Bridge Rd) toward Tysons Corner
- Turn Right onto International Dr.
- Make the first Left onto Greensboro Dr.
- Once on Greensboro Drive, make the first RIGHT into parking lot

From the Toll Road/Dulles Access Road

- Exit the Toll Road at Spring Hill Rd. near the main toll plaza (\$0.50 toll)
- At end of exit ramp, head toward Tysons Corner
- Follow the road straight; it becomes International Dr.
- Driving on International Drive, cross Westpark Drive and see the KPMG building on your right
- Make the next right onto Greensboro Drive (Tysons II mall is on your left)
- Once on Greensboro Drive, make the first RIGHT into parking lot

There are 2 options for visitor parking:

1. Garage parking - paid parking; \$6 for 3hrs
2. Visitor surface parking - free, 2 hour max; there are 12 spaces designated for visitor parking for 2 hours or less. These spaces are located on the way to the garage, immediately as you turn into the surface lot and head toward the garage. Look for painted "Visitor" designations on the spaces.

PARKING at 8200 GREENSBORO DR.

Parking at 8200 Greensboro is ALMOST ALL RESERVED on the outdoor surface level. There are several surface spaces near the front entrance that are designated as visitor parking. These spaces are marked by paint on the asphalt: "Visitor Parking - 2 hours." Note that building management has been chalking tires of cars to check for over-staying the 2 hour limit.

All unmarked spaces are RESERVED for permits only, and there is a risk of TOWING. (It hasn't happened yet, but we don't want you to be the first of our clients to be towed.)

Parking in the garage is pay parking (\$6 for 3 hours).

If using the garage, please park in the visitor's section

The visitor's parking is actually located underneath the building next door (8180 Greensboro), so you'll need to get to 8200 via one of the 2 methods below.

GETTING TO 8200 once inside the garage

I. IF THE WEATHER IS NICE (this is the easier way):

You can get to 8200 by popping up to the surface inside 8180, and then walking outside to 8200 (a very short, 30-second walk)

1. Look for a stairwell behind with a sign that says "8180 Elevators"
2. Take the elevators to the Lobby Level
3. Exit the Lobby via the larger set of glass doors
4. Turn right and walk next door to 8200

II. IF THE WEATHER IS BAD (or you want a little underground adventure):

You can walk to 8200 from the visitor's parking area without going outside.

→ *Bonus points are awarded to anyone who can navigate this without getting lost.*

To help you earn those bonus points, here's the secret:

1. Once you've parked in the visitor's section, begin walking away from the elevator bay and look left
2. Find the signs hanging from the ceiling that say "Tunnel to 8200"
3. Go through the door under the "Tunnel to 8200" sign; you will be facing a metal gate
4. Open the metal gate and go down
5. Exit the stairwell, and you will find yourself in a lower level of the garage
6. Walk immediately left and find sign for "Tunnel"
7. Enter the double-doors under "Tunnel" sign, and go up the stairs inside the passageway
8. Exit into the garage (you are now underneath 8200)
9. Look ahead and slightly left for large green "8200" numbers painted on the wall
10. Walk to the door under the painted "8200" sign; enter and take the elevators to the 9th floor
